

Paper Rosette / Bunting

Ingredients to make a 10" diameter rosette:

10" x 30" Your choice of paper 6" Wax twine Ribbon in length of choice (to hang down from)\ Double-sided tape Ruler and bone folder optional

Instructions:

Once you have selected your papers, select wax twine to match the color as closely as possible; you'll use this to secure and attach the rosettes in the center.

Using a ruler, wrap a pleat (approx. 1" wide) and with a bone folder, crease the fold, flip over and wrap the paper to the ruler's edge and crease. Accordian pleat all the way through the length of the paper.

Squeeze the pleats together, mark the center of the rosette, secure with the 6" of waxed twine, using a square knot to secure. Bring the two sides of the top pleat together and tape along the cut edge. Repeat with the opposite edge.

Punch a hole in the top and string with ribbon to hang.



The width of the pleat will be the diameter of your rosette.

The wider your rosette the longer you need paper to pleat with (approx. 3x's the width)

Tissue is more fragile so you might want to double-up your paper to create extra stiffness.
